Training Program on Grafted Vegetable Technology

Grafting vegetables can protect crops against many soil-borne diseases and can improve crop tolerance. VNR Nursery has developed effective grafting techniques for brinjal, tomato, chili, and few cucurbits. Vegetable grafting is popular among farmers in Taiwan, Japan, Korea and Vietnam and there are good business opportunities to expand this method in India.VNR Nursery has devised a unique training cum hands-on workshop program on grafted vegetable technology to train progressive agriculturist on this upcoming business opportunity. These programs are based on the concept of Listening in Knowing & Learning by Doing. VNR Nursery's prime focus is to develop a business model for profitability and welfare of
