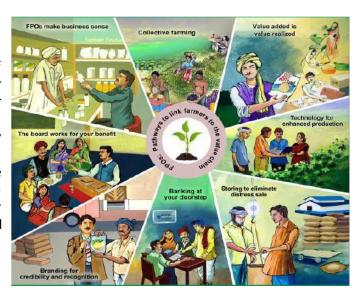




Targeting 10,000 New FPO 2027-28

Farmers Producer Organisation (FPO) The Government of India has approved and launched the Central Sector Scheme of "Formation and Promotion of 10,000 Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs)" to form and promote 10,000 new FPOs till 2027-28 with a total budgetary outlay of Rs.6865 Cr. FPO's can be registered under Cooperative Societies Act/ Autonomous or Mutually Aided Cooperative Societies Act of the respective State, Multi-State Cooperative Society Act, 2002, Producer Company under Section 581(C) of Indian Companies Act, 1956, as amended in 2013. Area of its operations can be entire union of India. As informed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh, a total of 852 FPOs have been formed till 2020 in Andhra Pradesh.



Features

It is formed by a group of producers for either farm or non-farm activities. It is a registered body and a legal entity. Producers are shareholders in the organization. It works for the benefit of the member producers. A part of the profit is shared amongst the producers. Rest of the surplus is added to its owned funds for business expansion

Activities

Procurement of inputs, disseminating market information, technology and innovations. Facilitating finance for inputs. Aggregation and storage of produce, primary processing like drying, cleaning and grading, brand building, Packaging, Labelling and Standardization.

Quality control, marketing to institutional buyers, Participation in commodity exchanges & exports. As per the Evaluation Report of Pricewaterhouse Coopers (PwC) on FPO component titled "Impact Study 7- Enhanced realization of agriculture produce marketed through PCs/FCSCs under Maharashtra Agricultural Competitiveness Project (MACP)" brings out the following major points:

- (i) Sale through Farmer Producers Companies (FPCs) has resulted in increased price realization by members by 22%
- (ii) Incidence of cost of marketing is 31% lower than other channels
- (iii) 28 percent of members have purchased inputs from PCs and it has resulted into net savings of Rs.1384 per acre.

FPOs can engage farmers in collective farming and address productivity issues emanating from small farm sizes, employment generation due to the increased intensity of farming. FPO can help farmers compete with large corporate enterprises by increasing bargaining power. Enable members to save time, transaction costs, distress sales, price fluctuations, transportation, quality maintenance, etc. Social capital will develop in the form of FPOs, as it may lead to improved gender relations and decision-making of women farmers in FPOs. This may reduce social conflicts and improved food and nutritional values in the community.

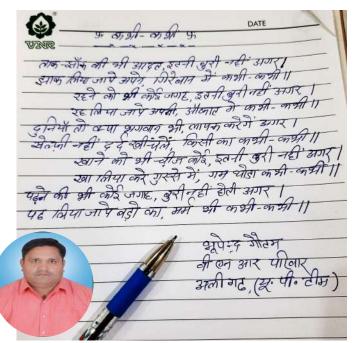

'Tutti Frutti' Cake Recipe

Ingredients

Butter: 3 tbsp
 Oil: 3 tbsp

3) Powder sugar: 1/3 cup

4) Condensed milk: 3/4 cup o 240 g

5) Milk: 1 cup/240ml 6) Vinegar: 1.5 tsp

7) Choice of essence: 1 tsp

8) Flour or Maida: 1.5 cups/195g

9) Baking soda: 1/2 tsp 10) Baking powder: 1.5 tsp

11) Tutti Frutti

To make batter for cake,

- 1) Mix butter, oil, and sugar in a bowl.
- 2) Add condensed milk in it and mix it well.
- 3) Now take a 1 cup of milk and add vinegar and vanilla essence in it.
- 4) Mix flour, baking powder and baking soda in a separate bowl.

Now slowly add milk and flour mixture to condensed milk mixture and mix it well. Bake it at 180 degrees for 45 mins. Let it cool before serving.
